Dear Saint Rose of Lima Catholic School Community,

It has truly been a great year at Saint Rose of Lima Catholic School! There have been many highlights but none greater than the 75th Anniversary Celebration of our school. Founded in 1941, Saint Rose has been an important part of the Roseville community for these past 75 years.

Our financial goal for the event was to raise \$75,000 to help support our educational endeavors in the school. We achieved that goal while also connecting with many new and old friends. Alumni and businesses were contacted, parishioners and teachers, both current and past, were approached and we opened our doors to all who were in any small way a part of our history.

I wanted to reach out and thank all of you. Because of your generosity, we will have new Language Arts/English textbooks in the classrooms next year. We have purchased 25 computers that travel between classrooms on a Chromebook Laptop cart, with a second one on order. Professional Development opportunities have been given to teachers to look at how to better use technology in the classrooms as well as ways to better meet student needs. The school's infrastructure is being updated to meet the technology needs in all the classrooms. Finally, Saint Rose School staff will begin formulating a service program for our community that fits our school's mission.

Again, I would like to thank all of you. This could not have been accomplished without your generosity. I continue to praise God for all the wonderful people he has bestowed upon our school and parish. Thank you for your continued support.


