



Frequently Asked Questions

Do children have to be Catholic to attend Saint Rose?

No, parents and children do not have to be Catholic to be enrolled at Saint Rose. We have a number of non-Catholic students who we believe feel welcome, comfortable, and a part of our school family. All children do participate in daily religion classes and prayer experiences.

What is the average class size?

Currently our average class size is 13 students.

Are all teachers credentialed and licensed?

Yes, all teachers hold BA or BS degrees in education and are fully licensed by the State of Minnesota. A number of our teachers also hold post graduate credits and degrees in education.

Can my child be bused to school?

Students in grades PK-8 can receive transportation services if living within the boundaries of Saint Rose of Lima School, as determined by Roseville School District. The district's Transportation Director, Jim Monroe, can be contacted (651-635-1638) if you would like to confirm busing to a particular address.

How can tuition be paid?

Parents have two options for tuition payments. A single payment can be made by July 1st at a 1% discounted rate. Parents may also pay monthly utilizing the TADS Tuition Management system (automatic deductions via checking or savings account or credit card charges over 11 months beginning in July).

Other than tuition, are there any additional fees?

A \$50 registration fee per family is due upon registration for prekindergarten. If enrolling another child in our K-8 program, no Pre-K registration fee is due. A \$25 Activity Fee per child is due on or before the first day of class.

A \$100 registration fee per family is due upon registration for students in grades K-8. A \$100 per family Technology Fee is collected each year as well. We also hold fundraisers, including the Marathon for Non-public Education. Each family is responsible for a minimum of \$250 towards this fundraiser, depending on the number of children enrolled. There are occasionally other small fees attached to field trips and other enrichment activities, depending on a child's grade.

Is daycare available?

Yes, we have a Prekindergarten Extended Daycare which is open on school days from 7:00 AM-5:30 PM. Students in grades K-8 are invited to use Power Play Education, an on-site extended day care program operated by our music teacher, Ms. Linn Ahrendt. Both programs have their own fee schedules depending on the number of hours and days care is needed.

What is the cost to attend the Prekindergarten program for the 2018-2019 school year?

3 Year Old Program (Tuesday & Thursday, 8:00-11:00)	\$1,500 (\$167/Month)
4 Year Old Program (Monday, Wednesday, Friday, 8:00-11:00)	\$2,000 (\$222/Month)
4 Year Old Program (Monday through Friday, 8:00-11:00)	\$3,500 (\$389/Month)
4 Year Old Program, Full Time Care (Monday through Friday, 7:00-5:30)	\$9,500 (\$1,055/month)

What is the cost to attend grades K-8 for the 2018-2019 school year?

First enrolled student	\$4,760
Second enrolled students	\$4,285
Each additional enrolled student	\$4,050
Kindergarten	\$3,250

Is Tuition Assistance Available?

Families may apply for tuition assistance through TADS. Applications are due by April 20. Families are also welcome to apply for Aim Higher Foundation grants through TADS as well. The deadline for application is February 15.
