CLASSROOM GOALS/EXPECTATIONS/HOMEWORK

Homework is given out on a daily basis and for the most part it is due the next school day. Projects and longer assignments are also given throughout the year that coincide with the subject curriculum.

RULES/GUIDELINES

Rules are posted in the classroom for all students to see and are expected to be followed by all. Consequences are given when the rules are not followed. For example, when a student does not turn in a completed assignment on the due date, it is considered "late". Students will lose 10% of their score for each school day the assignment is late.

Communication is done through e-mail, progress reports, phone calls, notes, Friday Folders, etc. The easiest and most preferred communication for me is e-mail.

CELEBRATIONS

Various holiday and other celebrations happen throughout the year. Notes will be sent home at least a week before.
